



OUR PROGRAMS



New Generation International Schools offers a comprehensive international American academic program. Although English is the main language of instruction and communication in the school, we strongly believe in the importance of embracing the Arabic Language's heritage and highly improving its proficiency level. NG offers the students a well-balanced approach to education through strong academic programs in both English and Arabic while instilling and deepening a belief in the community's culture and sense of belonging.

The integrated curriculum of the school includes advanced Arabic Social Studies, Religious Studies and Character Building. In addition, NG implements the Ministry of Education's Arabic, Arabic Social Studies & Religious Studies syllabi for students in grades 6, 9 and 12.



The school seeks to educate a new generation of children with expertise in the English language while maintaining linguistically strong Arabic skills. By doing so, students develop a profound understanding of their cultural beliefs and identity as well as their community. In addition, French is offered from K-11 and German is offered from grades 9 to 11. Elective courses are offered across the board in performing, musical, visual arts and informational technology. Extra-curricular activities including SAT are offered to students after school on a semester basis.



NG administers and houses support unit for students from K-5 that aids students individually to develop their educational skills according to their abilities and levels. The school also uses formative and summative assessments that measure students' performance. The NWEA's Measures of Academic Progress® (MAP®) test is administered twice annually to our students from grades 3 to 8.

Instruction is provided to students from K-12. Advanced Placement (AP) and SAT classes are offered to our high school students who receive coaching in both AP and SAT on a daily basis.



The founders of the school express the belief that NG has a national, ethical and social obligation to bring forth generations who can confidently contribute to society and be visionary leaders.
